# SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

- School Meals: Mr. Middleton informed the board that the distribution of school meals due to Covid-19 is up twice as much from 2 weeks ago. JCD is presently distributing 145 150 meals. Many thanks to Mr. Fehribach, Mr. Craddock and Mr. Middleton, the cafeteria staff and all others who are making this process possible.
- Graduation: Mr. Middleton assured the board that there is much thought going into what needs to be
  done for graduation. There are many involved in this decision. He thanked Mr. Fred Unsicker, High
  School Principal, for all his work with this. Mr. Unsicker informed the board that he has also had some
  virtual meetings with several seniors regarding this situation. There is no real answer at this time and
  JCD is waiting on directive from the state and will definitely keep everyone informed with regards to
  when and what decision is made.
- Hot Spots: Hot spots in the area include: Upper Room, JCD High School Parking Lot, REMC, Osgood
  First Baptist Church, Napoleon Community Center, Millhousen (has a connection with ETC.), Delaware
  Church, and there may be others not known at this time. JCD is thinking about possibly doing a survey
  on Facebook regarding needs of other hotspots or internet connections and about what has worked
  and not worked through all of this.

- **Great Work Everyone:** Mr. Middleton commended everyone on all their hard work in this very trying time. He stated that he is so impressed with the camaraderie that is ever present in all this and he is very much proud to say that he is a part of JCD.
