SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

- Mr. Middleton commented that we are in the testing season with both buildings. He recognized all
 those teachers, aides, and para's that go above and beyond during this time. There are many that
 must be extra flexible, and Middleton mentioned he was grateful for all involved in testing during
 this time.
- Mr. Middleton went on to talk about the resignation of the SRO and how he has been a staple for security and safety throughout the JCD campus. Middleton explained that there was no ill-will towards any employee or the Board, but that he was simply changing environments. Middleton stated that he wishes the very best for Mr. Goris in in next position as SRO and thanked him for his many efforts to keep and maintain JCD as a safe place for staff and students.
- Mr. Middleton presented some quick information about the storm damage from the tornado that took place several weeks ago. Middleton shared that many of the items damaged have been sent to insurance and are awaiting approval to begin the reconstruction process. Among one of those items was a damaged score board that needs to be replaced. Middleton mentioned that the corporation activities coordinator will work with a company to provide two additional scoreboards at no cost to the corporation, but rather through the local community's support.
- Lastly, Middleton talked about an audit that was conducted with positive results. The audit was to
 prevent workplace injury and only a few suggestions were shared. Middleton explained that he
 was happy to hear the results and will begin the process of reviewing the suggestions and moving
 forward as he saw fit.
