- The board thanked the administration for keeping them up-to-date on happenings at Jac-Cen-Del.

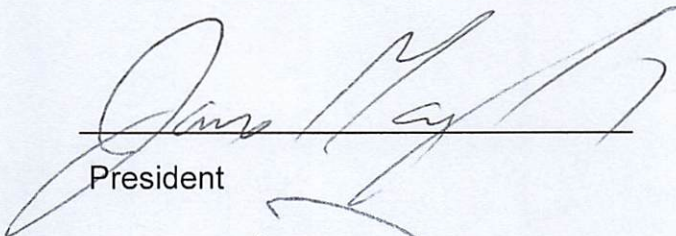
Next Meeting
